Please use the sketch map and comments box inside this leaflet but more importantly, if you can, please come along and talk to us on Saturday November 24th to start to plan for the future.

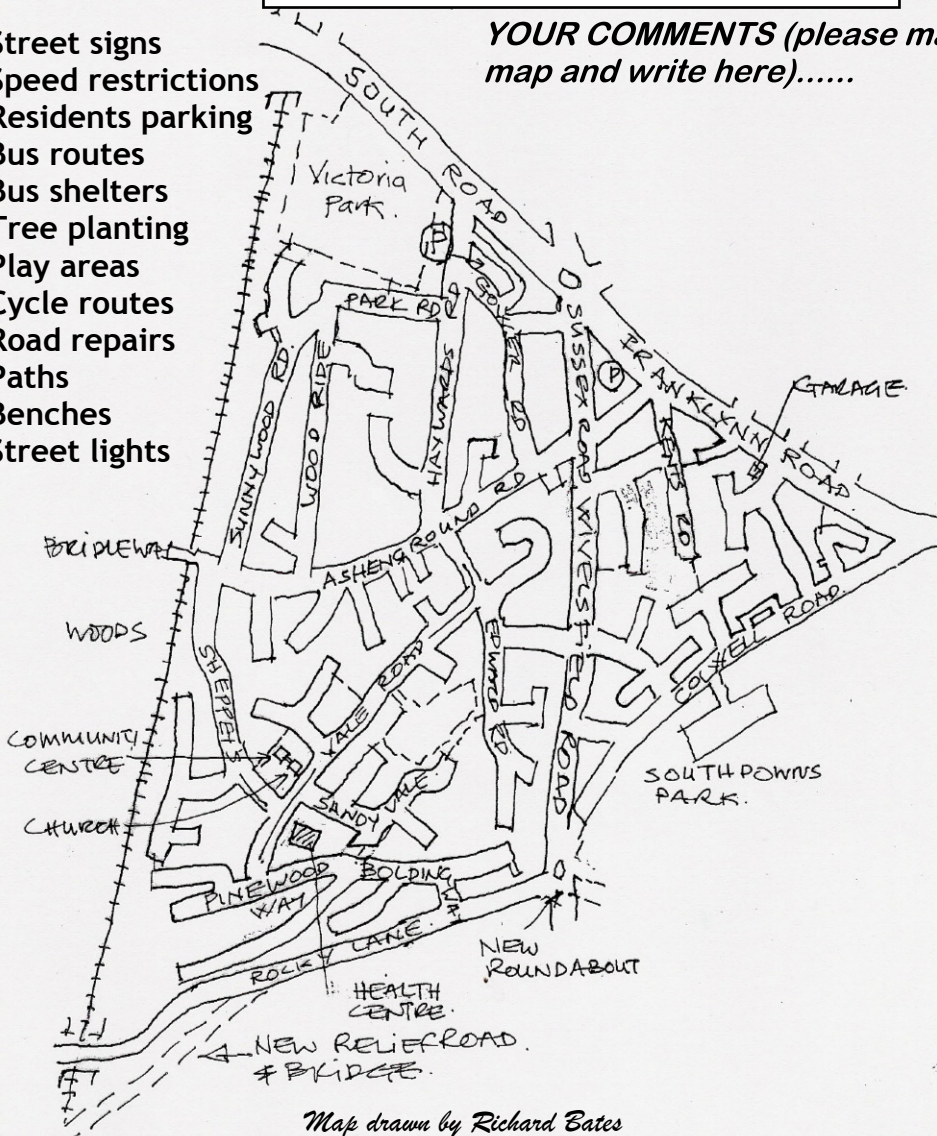
